Low hemoglobin levels (often leading to anemia) can cause fatigue, weakness, and other serious health complications. Awareness about maintaining optimal hemoglobin levels is crucial, especially for college students who often face stress, irregular diets, and sleep deprivation, which can negatively affect their health.

### **3. Results and Observations**

Initial surveys indicate that a large percentage of college students lack basic knowledge about hemoglobin and anemia. The workshops, seminars, and blood donation camps saw active participation from students, indicating a growing interest in healthrelated topics. Students were especially engaged in the interactive activities such as quizzes and games, which helped reinforce the learning in a fun and memorable way.

#### **3.3. Impact of the Campaign**

Postcampaign surveys revealed a marked improvement in students' understanding of hemoglobin's role in the body and its impact on overall health. A significant number of students reported taking proactive steps after the campaign, such as incorporating ironrich foods into their diets or scheduling a health checkup.

### **4. Discussion**

#### **4.1. Importance of Hemoglobin Awareness**

For college students, who often have fluctuating lifestyles, balancing academics, extracurriculars, and social life, maintaining good hemoglobin levels is critical. Anemia can lead to chronic fatigue, reduced academic performance, and poor overall health. The campaign highlighted the fact that many students were unaware of how anemia could affect their quality of life.

#### **4.2. Role of Nutrition and Lifestyle in Maintaining Hemoglobin Levels**

The campaign emphasized the role of balanced nutrition in maintaining healthy hemoglobin levels. Foods rich in iron, folic acid, and vitamin B12 are essential for hemoglobin production. Additionally, regular exercise and avoiding excessive alcohol consumption or smoking are key lifestyle factors in preventing anemia.

### 4.3. Need for Regular Health Checkups

The importance of periodic health screenings to monitor hemoglobin levels was a major takeaway from the campaign. Many students may experience early signs of anemia, but these symptoms are often dismissed as stress or tiredness. Regular checkups can help identify anemia early and facilitate timely intervention.

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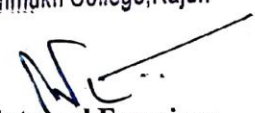
